

EPIM Cabot Global Equity

Investment objective and policy

These discretionary managed model portfolios offer risk-profiled investment solutions, all of which have a dynamic top-down asset allocation strategy implemented using low cost index tracking funds.

The investment objective for the EPIM Cabot Global Equity Model Portfolio is to provide a long-term total return which is superior to inflation plus 4% returns. The performance of the model portfolio is not intended to track the rise (or fall) of any specific index.

There was no 'Santa Claus rally' to close out 2022, with continuing hawkishness from central banks dampening any pre-Christmas optimism. Most equity markets fell in December, with the technology sector one of the leading losers, resulting in the Nasdaq Composite falling almost 9% over the month. Once again, the FTSE 100 outperformed and was essentially flat over the month.

Investors were hopeful that the Federal Reserve's (Fed's) reduction in the size of its interest-rate rises in December would mark the start of an easing trend that would continue. After raising rates by 75 basis points (bp) at its previous four meetings, the US central bank opted for a 50bp increase in borrowing costs - with the change well telegraphed to markets ahead of the decision. However, there was no let-up of the tough monetary talk from Jerome Powell, as the Fed chair signalled a determination to keep rates high until inflation is indisputably conquered. Mr Powell's tough talk caused concerns that further monetary tightening from central banks around the world increased the risk of a hard landing in 2023.

It is likely that inflation has peaked in the US and elsewhere – and 2023 should be a year of disinflation. Nevertheless, the rate of price increases remains elevated – and it will take some time before clear evidence emerges that inflation is heading towards central bank targets of 2%. Fed policymakers will also be closely watching the US jobs market, which continues to demonstrate significant strength.

Optimism around the prospects for Chinese equities has also improved after Beijing relaxed its "zero-Covid" policy amid protests at the social restrictions across the country and the significant hit to economic growth resulting from the stringent measures. Although an easing of the strict requirements should be positive for the Chinese economy, it has resulted in a significant surge in infections and deaths.

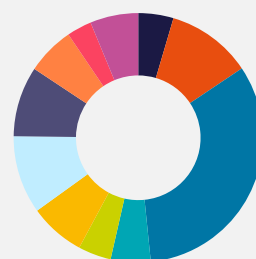

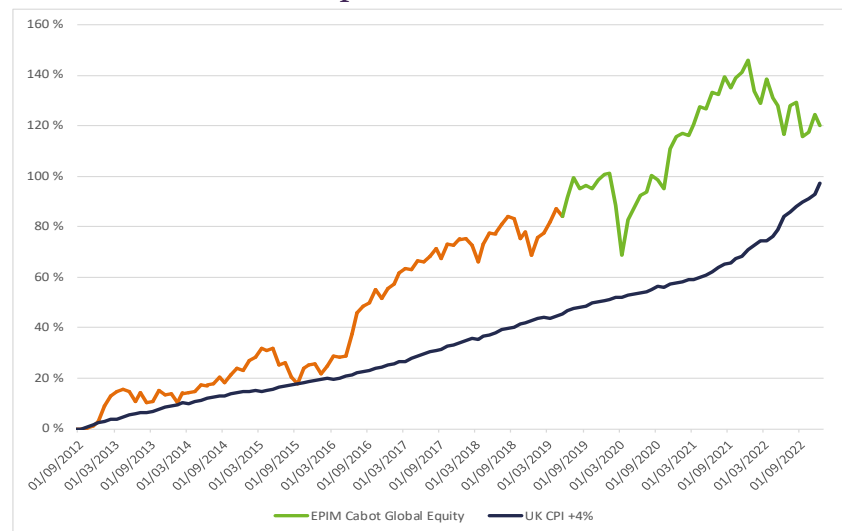
